When working with historic masonry, the mortar that you choose for repointing, plastering, or grouting may very well be the most important decision you make. Breathability and Permeability, Flexibility, and Strength are all very important factors that must be taken into account when making this decision. Inappropriate repair, or simply not working with the correct mortar can often mean the difference between a successful restoration and irreversible damage. Virginia Lime Works is here to help!



At Virginia Lime Works we use a select group of natural sands and blend them with our natural hydraulic lime. Natural Hydraulic Lime or NHL is made by burning limestone that is infiltrated with silica. They are produced at lower temperatures and during this burning process these silica become reactive. When this silica is hydrated (during mortar making, etc.), they will begin to harden and set. This hydraulic (water setting) action, allows for faster working times, increased compressive strengths and shortened curing without jeopardizing vapor permeability, flexibility, or compatibility.

Mix&GO Types and Descriptions

MORTARS

VLWVG12: MIX&GO 2:1 MORTAR (2 PARTS SAND TO 1 PART LIME)

Our best seller and a very common mortar throughout time. This mix is specially formulated for brick construction and repointing, but can also be used in stonework as well.

VLWVG25: MIX&GO 2.5:1 MORTAR (2.5 PARTS SAND TO 1 PART LIME)

Mix&GO 2.5:1 Mortar can be used in all the same places as our 2:1 Mortar, but has a higher sand content. Mix&GO 2.5:1 Mortar has good workability and is commonly used for stone construction, stone relaying, and stone repointing, but can be used for brickwork as well.

VLWVG11: MIX&GO BUTTERJOINT MORTAR (1 PART SAND TO 1 PART LIME)

Our Butterjoint Mix&GO was developed for the repointing and relaying of the pressed brickwork that is often seen in late 19th and early 20th century architecture. Rich and creamy, it a perfect restoration mortar for joint thicknesses of a quarter inch or less.

PLASTERS

VLWVGBC: MIX&GO BASECOAT (2 PARTS SAND TO 1 PART LIME)

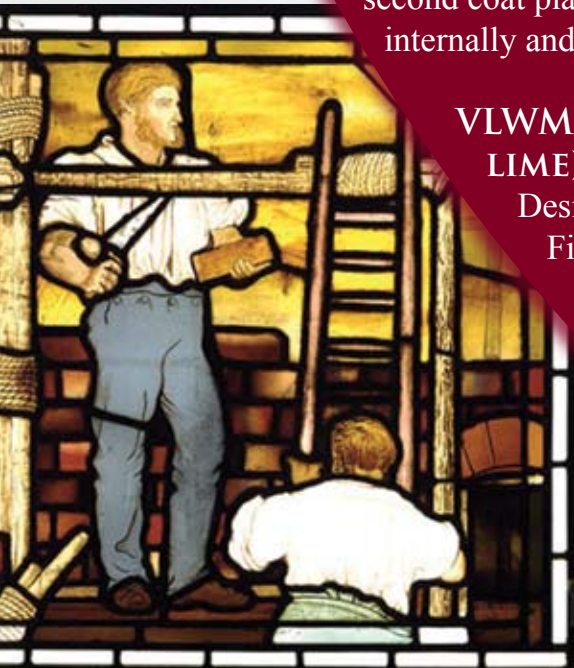
Specifically designed for use as a first coat plaster on lath. This richer mix made with a slightly coarser aggregate that enables the plaster to have maximized “keying” when applied to wood or metal laths. If plastering on metal lath, we recommend making this Mix&GO with NHL 5. We recommend the on-site addition of hair (horse or goat) if using Mix&GO BaseCoat on Wood or Metal Lath.

VLWVGRC: MIX&GO RENDERCOAT (2.5 PARTS SAND TO 1 PART LIME)

Mix&GO RenderCoat can be used as a first coat plaster directly onto masonry or as a second coat plaster on masonry or metal lath. Mix&GO RenderCoat can be used both internally and externally as a render/stucco.

VLWVGFC: MIX&GO FINISHCOAT (1 PART SAND TO 1 PART LIME)

Designed to be a finish plaster for interior work, we now offer both FinishCoat Interior and FinishCoat Exterior, for tighter more closed surface renders.
